# Goals

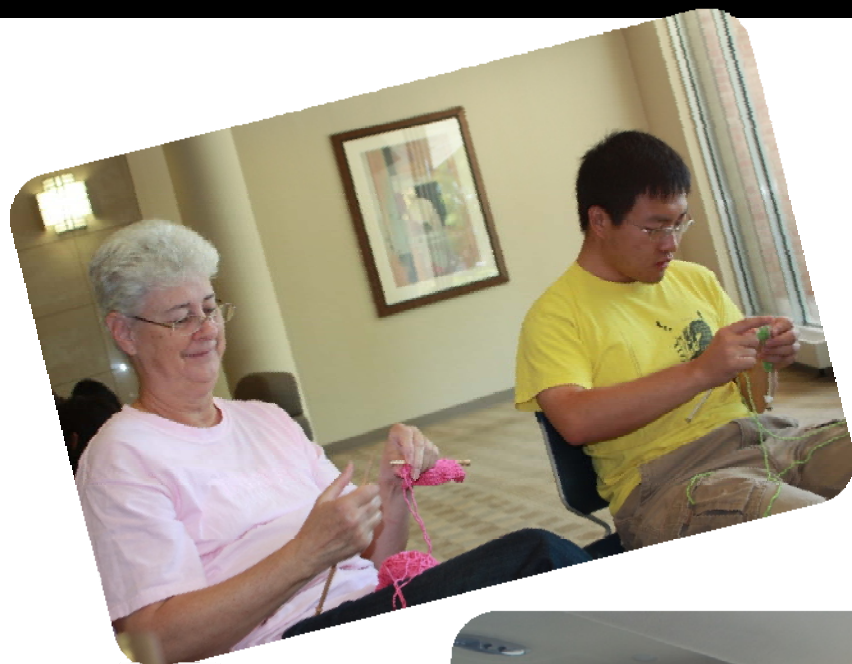


- One Saturday per month, University Housing will provide service opportunities with partner organizations for students.
